

Git Notes

Clone a specific tag

```
git clone --depth 1 --branch <tag_name> <repo_url>
```

Specify the private SSH-key to use when executing a Git command:

```
ssh-agent bash -c 'ssh-add /home/git/.ssh/key-filename; git $GIT_COMMAND'
```

Example:

```
ssh-agent bash -c 'ssh-add /home/git/.ssh/key-filename; git push'
```

Remove submodule

0. mv a/submodule a/submodule_tmp
 1. git submodule deinit -f - a/submodule
 2. rm -rf .git/modules/a/submodule
 3. git rm -f a/submodule # Note: a/submodule (no trailing slash)
- # or, if you want to leave it in your working tree and have done step 0
3. git rm -cached a/submodule
 - 3bis mv a/submodule_tmp a/submodule
